

Human Trafficking: One of the largest hidden crime industries

July 30th is World Day Against Trafficking in Persons. Global learned more about this epidemic through an educational workshop and supported a non-profit working to help this issue through a donation. Human trafficking is a \$150 billion industry and there are an estimated 40.3 million victims worldwide. These numbers are just the tip of the iceberg for this issue since human trafficking is a very well hidden crime. Reclaim 13 is a non-profit that operates two specialized therapeutic homes for survivors of sexual exploitation between the ages of 10 and 25. They provide the latest clinically-based healing and trauma-informed approaches to support a survivor's journey of reclaiming their path toward freedom. Global is proud to partner with this organization as they make a difference in the lives of survivors.
