September: Hispanic Heritage Month

Hispanic Heritage Month runs from September 15th to October 15th. You may be wondering, "Why is the start of the celebration in the middle of the month?" The reason actually lies in the abundance of independence celebrations held by Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua on the 15th. Additionally, Mexico and Chile celebrate their independence on the 16th and 18th. Currently, the Hispanic population makes up about 19% of the U.S. population and has increased by 23% over the past decade, outpacing the overall population growth of 7%. As a minority-owned business with many Hispanic brands to represent, the strength and influence of this population are a huge part of our business. This month employees joined our workshop to learn about the history of the Hispanic community in America and to honor the achievements of many Hispanic heroes. Looking towards the future, Global is supporting the next generation of Hispanic heroes with a gift to the Hispanic Scholarship Fund. HSF has awarded over \$675 million in scholarships and provides scholars access to support services including mentorship, leadership development programs, career services, and wellness training.

Hurricane Fiona Relief

Hurricane Fiona struck this month and devastated the Caribbean. It's estimated that 746,000 homes and businesses are still without power a week after the storm caused a power outage for 3.3 million Puerto Rico residents. In the Dominican Republic, over 1 million people are without water, and thousands are in need of other basic necessities. This category four hurricane caused significant damage in Puerto Rico, the Dominican Republic, Turks and Caicos, Bermuda, and Canada.





Our non-profit partner, Feed My Starving Children received requests for more than 1 million emergency response meals from their connections in the Caribbean. Global is thankful to have this connection with a partner who is actively helping during this emergency. In response to this need, Global made a donation on North Texas Giving Day which allowed our donation to be matched by other generous donors. Originally our donation would have been able to feed 11 children for a year but thanks to this matching we were able to feed twice as many kids and support the active relief efforts that FMSC is providing on the islands.
